

Henrietta Zweifel

June 17, 1895 - February 22, 1973

MONTICELLO - Mrs. Fred "Etta" Zweifel, 77, died Thursday February 22, 1973 at home after a long illness.

The former Henrietta Holcomb was born in Adams Township, the daughter of Rose (Blumer) and Ernest Holcomb, Sr. On Nov. 13, 1913, Henrietta Holcomb and Fred Zweifel, Jr. were married at the home of her uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. Dave Pfeiffer, in Monroe. Rev. P.A. Schuh of St. John's United Church of Christ officiated. Mr. and Mrs. Zweifel observed their 50th wedding anniversary in November, 1963. They farmed on the Zweifel Homestead farm in Washington Township for 54 years until retiring to the village of Monticello in April, 1967.

Surviving are her husband; a son, Clarence, and a daughter, Miss Lillian Rose Zweifel, both at home; and seven brothers, Clarence and Ira, Monticello; and Harold, Leon, Marvin, James and Arthur, all of Monroe.

Interment was in the Zwingli United Church of Christ Cemetery in New Glarus.
