Rites Held Friday for John R. Zweifel, 26

Funeral services for Johnnie R. Zweifel, 26 years of age. Belleville, who died of injuries received Monday night when a motorcycle he was riding struck a cow one-half mile south of Twin Grove, were held at 130 pm Friday at the Stuessy funeral home, Monroe

The Rev Wolfgang Koehler of St.. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe, officiated and burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

Death was attributed to crushing chest injuries. The cow was owned by William J. Rahberger, Route 1, Juda.

Born July 17, 1943, he was the son Fred and Lena Segessman Zweifel. He attended school in Belleville. For the past year and a half he had worked at Prairie Hill cheese factory for Howard Grossen, about a mile south of Twin Grove. Prior to that he had worked for Baker Manufacturing Co. in Evansville and later for the Disch Construction Co. in Belleville.

He is survived by his parents and a brother, Fred D. Zweifel, Route 2, Belleville.
