

Nellie E. Zweifel
September 4, 1887 - July 29, 1975

Funeral services for Mrs. Nellie Zweifel, 87, Monticello, who died Tuesday, July 29, were held Friday, August 1, in Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, with Rev. Charles Workman officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery. Eastern Star rites were held Thursday evening, July 31, in the Memorial Lounge of the Church. Mrs. Zweifel was the last charter member of the Monticello Chapter, OES, now consolidated with New Glarus Chapter.

The former Nellie E. Krueger was born in Mt. Pleasant Township, on September 4, 1887, a daughter of William and Augusta Gehler Krueger. She attended Silver rural school. She and John P. Zweifel were married in Monticello on Feb. 7, 1909, Mrs. Zweifel was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ and its Ladies Aid, the John Ross Woman's Relief Corps, and the New Glarus Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Mildred Hagon, Waunakee; Mrs. Thomas E. (Irma) Hamilton, Gaborone, Botswana, Africa, who has been in Monticello during her mother's last illness; two sons, Dwight, Monticello, and Edward W., Madison; one sister, Mrs. Mabel Rhyner, Albany; 13 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband in 1947; three brothers, Frank, Henry, and William; and two sisters, Mrs. Mary Stanton and Mrs. Emma Holliday.
