Mrs. Lena Zwickey, 88 Dies Saturday

Rites Held Tuesday P. M. for Resident of Village for Many Years

Private funeral services for Mrs. Lena Zwickey, 88 years of age and a resident of Monticello for many years, who passed away at 2:45 Saturday afternoon at the Green county hospital, Monroe, were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. L. A. Brown, pastor of the Evangelical United Brethren church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Henry J. Elmer, John Elmer, Willis J. Marty, C. M. Stauffer, Louis Wyss, and Dwight Zweifel.

Mrs. Zwickey's death resulted from old age complications.

Lena Craver was born in Saxony, Germany, March 19, 1863. She came to America when she was a small child and spent the rest of her life in Green county. She was married to Fred Zwickey.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Wilma Blumer, Monticello; one step-daughter, Mrs. George Bidlingmaier, Monroe; two grandsons, Robert E. Blumer, Monticello, and Paul F. Blumer, Rantoul, Ill; and two step-grandsons, Carl and Raymond Bidlingmaier, Monroe. She was preceded in death by her husband.
