

## **Abbott. Mrs. Fred (Helen L.)**

MONTICELLO — Mrs. Fred (Helen L.) Abbott. age 74, of Monticello, died Friday, July 2, 1982, at Monroe.

She was the daughter of Henry C. and Minnie Marty Klassy. She was a graduate of the Monticello High School, class at 1926. That year she was married to Clarence H. Elmer and they farmed near Monticello until 1953 when they moved to the village of Monticello. Mr. Elmer died in 1963. She was married in 1967 to Fred Abbott, who survives.
