Alfred E. “Butch” Aeberhard, age 77 of New Glarus, formerly of Monticello, died Sunday, September 9, 2012 at the New Glarus Home surrounded by his family. Al was born December 15, 1934 in Monticello, the son of Alfred C. and Leora B. (Cotherman) Aeberhard. He married Mary Scheidegger on July 5, 1958 at St. Johns Church in Monroe.
