Melchoir Aebly is Victim of Apoplexy

Wife Sees His Head Drop As He Rests In Chair.

Monticello- Melchoir Aebly, aged 76. died at his home here Sunday afternoon after an illness of a few hours following a stroke of apoplexy. He was sitting in a chair when his wife noticed his head drop. He did not reivive.

He had not been feeling well last week but was able to go down town on Saturday. He formerly farmed in Washington township and moved to Monticello nine years ago.
