Marion R. Agen, age 85 of 110 West Maple Avenue, Barron, WI, died Thursday, April 6, 2000 at her home. She was born June 24, 1914 in Green County, Wisconsin to Henry and Susanna (Zimmerman) Elmer.

Marion grew up and graduated from high school in Monticello, Wisconsin. She then attended and graduated from Whitewater State Teacher's College in 1933.
