

Mrs. John Altman Aged 73, Succumbs; Rites Held Tuesday

Aged Local Lady Victim Of Heart Attack After 2-Month Illness

Funeral services for Mrs. John C. Altman, 73 years of age, a resident of the village for the past year and a half, who passed away at 8:15 Saturday morning (Aug. 16, 1947) at her home on Monroe street following an illness of approximately two months' duration, were held at 2 Tuesday afternoon in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Pallbearers were Adam Schuler, Otto E Bontly, Alloert Knobel. Walter Hadinger, John P. Zweifel, Monticello, and Clarence Keehn, Brooklyn.

Mrs. Altman suffered from a heart ailment and was in a critical condition for about a week before her death.

Mrs. Altman, the former Selina Ellen Dalrymple, was born in Brooklyn township April 26, 1874. She graduated from the Monroe high school and the Green County Normal school at Monroe. She taught rural school in Green county for 20 years. On May 1, 1911, she was united in marriage to John C. Altman. Mr. and Mrs. Altman farmed in Mt. Pleasant township for more than 30 years, moving to Monticello to make their home March 1, 1946.

Mrs. Altman is survived by her husband; one daughter, Mrs. Ralph Zimmerman, Monticello, and one grandson. She was preceded in death by her parents and three brothers.
