### **Baebler rites are scheduled**

Services for Fred Baebler, 70, former Monticello area and Janesville resident, who died on Saturday, July 2, 1977, at International Falls, Minn., where he had lived since 1973, were held Wednesday, July 6, at Green-Larsen Memorial Chapel, International Falls, with graveside service and burial Friday at Britten, S.D.

Mr. Baebler was born July 3, 1906, in Green County. He was married to Ena Jones on Jan. 22, 1928, in Langford, S. D. They lived there several years and then in Monticello until his service with the Army during World War II. After the war they lived in Janesville where he was employed 16 years at General Motors before moving to International Falls. He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.
