

CARL J. DICK

Carl J. Dick, age 92, a life long Monticello resident, died Tuesday, September 17, 2002 at the New Glarus Home.

Carl was born January 16, 1910 in Monticello, the son of John and Anna (Messerli) Dick. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1927 and Madison Business College in 1931. He and Walt Haddinger owned a trucking business until Carl entered the U.S. Army on Sept. 25, 1942. He was honorably discharged on Nov. 22, 1945.

Carl worked for Wis. Power and Light from 1949 until 1959 and from 1960 until 1970 was self-employed as a contractor for a power line clearance company based out of Monticello. He was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Carl loved to bicycle and in his later years enjoyed walking the Sugar River Trail and driving the countryside.

Survivors include three nieces, Donna Karlen of Monticello, Marylis (Lester) Cramer of Prairie du Sac, and JoAnn Weatherly of Orange Beach, AL. He was preceded in death by two brothers, Waldo Dick in 1991, and Wilbert Dick in 1996; two sisters, Hilda Karlen in 1990, and Lora Dick in 1995; and a niece, Barbara Davis.

Graveside services will be held Friday, September 20, 2002, at 11:00 a.m., at Highland Cemetery, Monticello, with Rev. Lawrence Balleine of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, officiating. A memorial fund will be established in Carl's name for Zwingli United Church of Christ.
