

JACOB H. DISCH

Jacob H. Disch, 83, 441 E. Coates Ave., Monticello, died Sunday, Sept. 14, 1975, in St. Clare Hospital after a short illness. He was born in Exeter Township, near Exeter Crossing on July 24, 1892, the son of Henry and Barbara Babler Disch. He attended Wallace rural school and was married to the former Madaline Lint, on Feb. 8, 1917, in the Monticello Zwingli Church by the late A. A. Muehlmeier. They farmed in Exeter Township from 1917 until 1945 and then was employed by Libby, McNeil and Libby, Co., Janesville until his retirement in 1968. Mr. Disch was a Monticello resident since 1961. Mr. and Mrs. Disch celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary on February 8, 1967.
