MONTICELLO—Clark J. Dooley, 73, W3897 Gilbertson Road, Monticello, died Friday, Aug. 1, 1986, at St. Clare Hospital. He had been hospitalized since July 22.

Mr. Dooley was born Oct. 3, 1912, at Sheboygan, the son Edmund and Elva (Clark) Dooley. He attended rural Green County schools.
