### **TWO MEMBERS OF FAMILY DIE IN EIGHT HOURS**

#### **HENRY DOOLY'S WIFE AND FATHER PASS AWAY NEAR THE SAME TIME**

#### **Death of Mrs. Dooly Came at Deaconess Hospital**

#### **Following Operation Performed 10 Days Ago.**

Mrs. Henry Dooly, who resides east of Monticello, passed away at the Deaconess hospital here this morning at 9:30 o'clock, following an operation performed ten days ago.

Following his wife's death this morning, Mr. Dooly was called to Monticello by the sudden death of his father, Richard Dooly, a well known farmer, who resides a half-mile west of Monticello. Richard Dooly passed-away this morning at 2 o'clock, ten minutes after he was stricken with apoplexy.

Henry Dooly has the sympathy of many Monroe friends in the loss of his wife and father within eight hours.

#### **Fine Neighbor and True friend.**

Mrs. Henry Dooly was 38 years of age. She was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Abraham Kubli, her maiden name being Mary Kubli. She lived in Monticello 20 years, where she was known as a fine neighbor and true friend. Her marriage to Henry Dooly took place there 13 years ago. Mr. and Mrs. Dooly lived on a farm a half-mile east of Monticello.

Besides her husband, she is survived by three sisters and five brothers. They are Mrs. Lydia Wittenweiler, Montello, Wis; Mrs. Ida Swan, Attica, Wis; Mrs. Anna Wittenweiler, Monticello; Abraham and Conrad Kubli, Monticello; John Kubli, Sylvester township; Dan Kubli, Walworth, Wis. and Henry F. Kubli of this city. She was a member of the Lutheran church at Monticello.

The remains were taken to Shriner's undertaking parlors. They will be taken to Monticello for burial.
