

**Mrs. R. K. Dugdale, Age 65,
Local Native, Succumbs Monday**

Mrs. Richard K. Dugdale, Sr., 65 years of age, Cascade, Colo., died Monday afternoon, Aug. 16 1971, at the Mamie Eisenhower Hospital, Colorado Springs, Colo. Death was attributed to complications following surgery.

Helen Karlen was born in Monticello, Aug. 5, 1906, the daughter of the late Herman L. and Lena Steinmann-Karlen. She graduated from, the Monticello high school in 1924, attended Stout University in 1925 to 1926, and graduated from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, in 1928.

She taught school in Blanchardville before her marriage to Richard K. Dugdale on Jan. 31, 1933. They lived in Lebanon and Sheridan, Ind., from 1933 until 1955, and then in Monticello for a short period of time. In 1956 the Dugdales built an authentic Swiss Chalet on the Ute Pass, Pikes Peak Highway, Colo., and then the Swiss Miss import business, also located there.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, Richard, Jr., Littleton, Colo., and Tom, Cascade, Colo.; two grandchildren; and two brothers, Royal W. and Cloyance W. Karlen, Monticello.
