

## LEONA MARIE ELMER

Leona Marie Elmer, age 93, of Monticello passed away on Saturday, July 12, 2003 at Graceland Manor in Monroe. Leona was born in Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, Wisconsin on November 7, 1909, the daughter of Isaac and Louisa (Gempelcr) Babler. Leona graduated from Monticello High School in 1927 and later married John C. Elmer on February 20, 1929 at St. John's United Church of Christ in Monroe. After their marriage they resided on the Elmer Homestead Brown Swiss Dairy Farm of Monticello. In 1991 Leona moved to the J.C. Elmer Subdivision in Monticello and was a resident of Graceland Manor since January 2002.



She was a long-time member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, the Women's Guild, adult fellowship groups and for over fifty years a member of the Zwingli Ladies Aid.
