Llewellyn Elmer age 89, of Monticello, died Saturday, March 16, 2002 at her home following a courageous battle with cancer. Llewellyn was born October 30, 1912, in Jefferson Township, Green County, Wisconsin, the daughter of John and Eva (Kline) Wittwer.
