Lucille F. Elmer, age 97, formerly of Monticello, died Wednesday, April 2, 2008 at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe. Lucile was born June 25, 1910 in Monticello, the daughter of Jacob H. and Emma (Jordi) Freitag. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1927 and married Wilbert D. Elmer on February 14, 1930.



Lucille and Wilbert owned a mink farm in rural Monticello for many years. Following Wilbert's death on March 26, 1973, Lucile continued operation of the mink farm until retiring in 1984.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello and St. Omar Order of the Eastern Star #90 for many years. She enjoyed gardening and loved to bowl, keeping active in both activities until age 91.
