

## **Mrs. Verna Feldt**

Mrs. Verna (Ben F.) Feldt, 83, Monroe, died Tuesday, Nov. 16, 1976, in the Monroe Manor Nursing Home. She had been in failing health for several years.

Verna M. Hawthorne, the daughter of William and Jennie Shank Hawthorne, she was born on Nov. 14, 1893, in Cadiz Township. She attended Saunders School and was graduated from the Green County Normal School in 1912. After teaching for several years, she was married on Dec. 16, 1915, to J. Clarence Kubly. They farmed until retiring in 1943. Mr. Kubly died in June 1943.

She was married to Ben F. Feldt in Monroe on Jan. 9, 1952.

Mrs. Feldt was a member of the United Methodist Church of Monroe. She had been a Sunday school teacher at Staver's Church for 25 years. She was a member of the Eastern Star, the Green County Regional Writers, Homemakers Club, a card club, and the Antique Wheelers Car Club. She and her husband traveled extensively, visiting Europe, Alaska, Hawaii, and nearly all of the United States.

She is survived by her husband, Ben; three step-children, Wallace, Rt. 1, Monticello, Mrs. Hans (Kathleen) Sulzer, Monticello, and Mrs. William (Ruth) Yarborough, Washington, D.C.; and five step-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her father in 1932, her mother in 1934, her first husband, and three brothers.

Funeral services were held on Friday, Nov. 19, in the United Methodist Church in Monroe, with Rev. John Francis officiating. Interment was in the Greenwood Cemetery.
