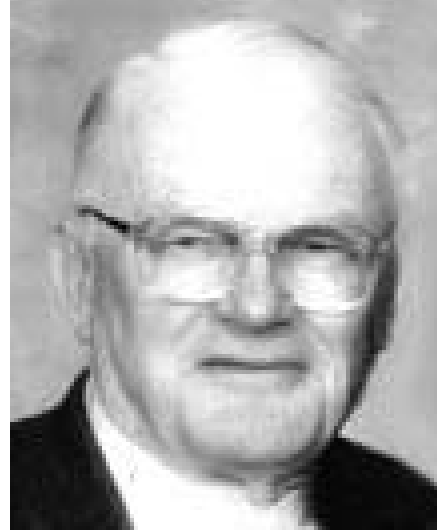


WALLACE KUNDERT FELDT

Wallace Kundert Feldt, age 82 of Monroe, formerly of Monticello, died on Monday, December 4, 2006 at the Monroe Manor following a long battle with cancer.

Wally was born December 1, 1924 in Monroe, the son of Ben F. and Marie Barbara (Kundert) Feldt. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1942. Wally and Elizabeth Gisler were united in marriage on September 1, 1956 at the Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello. Wally farmed in Mount Pleasant Township and was a salesman for Kent Feeds for many years before retiring in 1998.



He was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello; Past President of the Green County Shrine Club; a member of Zor Shrine of Madison; Past Master of New Glarus Masonic Lodge #310; and had served on the Monticello School Board and the Bank of Monticello Board of Directors.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth (Betty) Feldt; a son, Scott (Becky) Feldt, all of Monroe; two sisters, Kathleen (Hans) Sulzer of Monroe, and Ruth Yarborough of Madison; many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother-in-law, Bill Yarborough.
