

EMMA GAFNER

Emma Gafner, age 83 of Monticello, died Tuesday, January 5, 1999 at her home.

Emma was born July 11, 1915 in Koniz, Switzerland, daughter of the late Christian and Emma (Voegeli) Nydegger. She married Christian Gafner on March 16, 1940 in Niedersherli, Switzerland. He preceded her in death on August 11, 1991. Emma immigrated to Postville, Wisconsin on December 1, 1955. She and her husband farmed in several locations before settling in Monticello in 1964. Mrs. Gafner was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.
