

Henry Gale, Aged 77, Dies at Freeport
Former Monticello Citizen Answers Death Summons

Funeral services for Henry Gale, 77, Freeport, were held at his home in that city Thursday, with burial also taking place there. Mr. Gale died suddenly from a heart attack at his home there the preceding Monday. Mr. and Mrs. M. E. Lynn, Monticello, were among the Green county relatives who were present at the last rites. Mr. Lynn was a nephew of the deceased.

Mr. Gale spent many years in Monticello before moving to Freeport some 30 years ago, having been in the employ of the Illinois Central railroad as section foreman. He spent some years with the I. C. after locating in Freeport and later accepted a position with the Northern Illinois Utility company, serving in the capacity of plant superintendent. He was retired on a pension some years ago.

Mr. Gale is survived by two daughters, Alberta, who has a teaching position in Freeport, and Mayme, who has a similar position in the schools at Oak Park, Ill.
