

## **Krieg, Crescent Lydia Johannah**

MONTICELLO — Crescent Lydia Johannah Krieg “KoKo,” age 90, of Monticello, died Sunday, Dec. 19, 2004, at the Monroe Clinic Hospital.

Crescent was born May 3, 1914, in Chelsea, Wis., the daughter of John George and Selma Ella (Knauth) Lissner. She attended school in Whittlesey, Wis., and lived in the Medford area until she came to Monticello in 1936.

Crescent married Eugene Buechel on Jan. 13, 1934. He preceded her in death on April 3, 1936. She married John Jacob Krieg on June 3, 1939. He died May 29, 1971.
