

Daisy Loveland Lee

Mrs. Charles T. Lee, 73, Shullsburg, a native of Washington Township, died at 5:45 this morning in Memorial hospital, Darlington. She entered the hospital Wednesday.

She was the former Daisy Loveland, daughter of Frank and Maria Lemon Loveland, born March 14, 1890. She and Charles T. Lee were married Sept. 2, 1913, in the Loveland home in Monticello. They lived in Monticello for a short time and then moved to Shullsburg.

Mr. Lee is a member of the Lafayette County Board, had served on the Shullsburg police force and formerly operated a soft drink plant.

Mrs. Lee was a member of St. Mathew's Catholic church, Shullsburg, the Altar Rosary Society and Royal Neighbors lodge.

Surviving are the husband, a daughter, Sister Marie Mercedes, at Fairbault, Minn., formerly at Sinsinawa.

Mrs. Lee was a sister of the late Green County Judge William A. Loveland who died June 23, 1953. She also was preceded in death by three other brothers, Otto in 1930, Henry in 1945, and Frank J. in 1940, and a sister, Mrs. Matt (Ada) Klassy, March, 1934, in LeRoy, Minn. Her mother died March 6, 1942. Her father had died previously.
