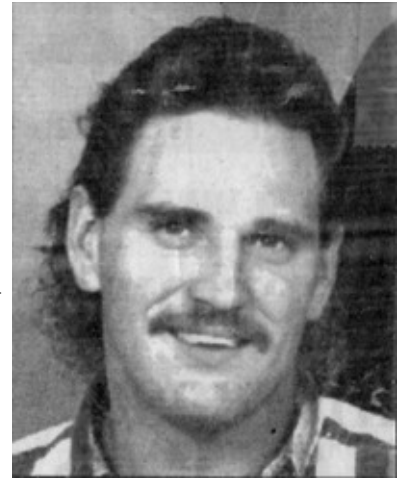


TODD LEHNHERR
