

Rites Held Monday For Mrs. Leonard, 89, New Glarus

Dec. 18, 1865 - Oct. 29, 1955

Funeral services for Mrs. Rosina Leonard, 89 years of age, New Glarus, who passed away at 3:20 Saturday morning at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Robert Holcomb, Sr., Monticello, were held at 2 Monday afternoon in the Zentner funeral home, New Glarus.

The Rev. Lynn F. B. Tschudy, pastor of the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, New Glarus, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery here.

Pallbearers were eight grandsons, Lawrence F. Marty, Robert C. Holcomb, Ray Gessler, Monticello, Edward Marty, Jr. Madison, Luverne Holcomb, Monroe, Morris Marty and John Zweifel, New Glarus, and Delmar Marty, Sun Prairie.

Mrs. Leonard's death was attributed to old age complications. She had been ill for the past nine months.

Rosina Hefty, daughter of Fredolin and Katherine Hefty Hefty was born on the Hefty homestead farm, Dec. 18, 1865. She attended rural schools and in 1883 she was united in marriage to J. C. Marty. They resided on the Marty farm in Washington township, now owned by Mrs. Bertha Loveland, until 1914, when they moved to New Glarus. Mr. Marty passed away in 1915. In 1916 she was married to Charles Leonard, who preceded her in death in 1940.

Mrs. Leonard was a member of the Swiss Evangelical and Reformed church, New Glarus.

She is survived by four sons, Fred C. and Edw. W. Marty, Monticello, Jacob Marty, New Glarus, and Walter Marty, Belleville; six daughters, Mrs. Herman D. Leger, Robinson, N. D., Mrs. Robert Holcomb, Sr., Mrs. Ira Holcomb, Mrs. Sylvia Curtis, Monticello, Mrs. Henry Gessler and Mrs. W. L. Zweifel, New Glarus; two sisters, Mrs. Barbara Lipchow and Mrs. Katherine Karlen, Monroe; 28 grandchildren, 59 great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her two husbands and a son in infancy, three half-sisters, Mrs. Fannie Goetz, Monroe, 1902, Mrs. Martha Kundert, Denver, 1922, and Mrs. Mary Kundert, Denver, in 1947, and two grandchildren.
