

IVAN E. MARTY

Ivan E. Marty, age 92, of Monticello, died Wednesday, July 30, 2003 at the New Glarus Home. Ivan was born February 10, 1911 in Washington Township, Green County, the son of Charles and Bertha (Rufer) Marty. He attended Purcell rural school and was confirmed at Washington Reformation Church in 1927. Ivan and Leona Zimmerman were united in marriage by the late Rev. Albert Muehlmeier on November 28, 1934 at the Zwingli Church Parsonage. The couple farmed in Washington Township for forty-one years before retiring and moving to Monticello in 1976.

Ivan was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, a former Treasurer of the Washington Church and Director of the Town Hall Cheese Factory. He enjoyed gardening and visiting the home farm following his retirement.

Survivors include his wife, Leona, Monticello; three children, Nathan (Lois) Marty, Madison, Anna Marie (Gary) Davison, Monticello, and Keith (Diana) Marty, Menomonee Falls.
