

## DAVID MOSER

The funeral for David Frederick Moser, 13, Rt. 1, Monticello, who died at his home on Monday evening, December 27, 1977, was held on Thursday, Dec. 30, at 1:30 p.m. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated and burial was in Highland Cemetery. Members of David's eighth grade class, teachers and other Junior High students attended the funeral services in a body.

He had been hospitalized several times since August, when he had undergone surgery at St. Clare Hospital in Monroe, and had been transferred to a Madison hospital.

The son of William P. and Carol R. Kundert-Moser, David was born in Monroe on April 10, 1963 and attended Monticello public schools.

He is survived by his parents; a brother, Michael, at home; a sister, Jane, Madison; his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Lydia S. Moser, Rt. 1, Monticello, and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Ralph J. Kundert, Monroe.

Preceding him in death was his grandfather, Fred W. Moser, on July 15, 1971.
