

Edwin Naef, 83, Monticello, Dies

Edwin Naef, 83, Monticello, a longtime farm area resident, died at 4:30 pm. Sunday, Feb. 8, 1970, at Wagner's Foster Care Home in Monroe. He had been a resident there since 1965.

Born in Kappel, Canton Zurich, Switzerland, on April 25, 1886, he was a son of Casper and Catherine Wyss Naef. He came to America, settling in Green County on Jan. 24, 1914. He worked as a farm hand.

There are no known survivors in the United States. There is a sister in Switzerland.

Services for Mr. Naef will be at 8 pm. Tuesday, Feb. 10, in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge at Monticello. Rev. J. Allen Mittler is to officiate. Burial will be Wednesday morning, Feb. 11, in Highland Cemetery in Monticello.
