

Royal "Bobby" Ritschard

Royal "Bobby" Ritschard, age 76, of Madison, died on Thursday, Oct 18 at Agrace Hospice in Fitchburg after a courageous battle with stomach cancer.

Royal was born July 21, 1936 in Monticello, the son of Herman and Emma (Grossen) Ritschard. He graduated from Monroe High School and entered the U.S. Army in August 1959. He was honorably discharged in August, 1961. Royal married Sun Bun Pak on June 28, 1961 in Seoul, Korea. He farmed until the age of 60. Following his retirement, Royal did maintenance and janitorial work for his daughter and son-in-law. He enjoyed watching and keeping up to date on all kinds of sports, especially high school basketball and football.
