Max W. Schuett, 83, Monticello, died Tuesday, June 30, 1998, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe.

He was born Aug. 21, 1914 in Newhall, IA, the son of Arthur and Ella (Naeve) Schuett. He graduated in 1931 from New Glarus High School. He married Mavis M. Blum on Nov. 26, 1936 in Monticello. Mrs. Schuett died Sept. 3, 1976.

Following their marriage, they made their home in Chicago for 10 years before returning to Monticello. In Monticello they operated the M&M Midway Lunch until he retired in 1989.
