

MRS. MAVIS (MAX) SCHUETT

The funeral for Mrs. Mavis (Max) W. Schuett, 66, Monticello, was held Monday, September 6, at 2 p.m. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where she was a member. Rev. Charles Workman officiated and interment was in Highland Cemetery.

Mrs. Schuett died unexpectedly Friday, Sept. 3, 1976, at her home, from a heart attack.

She was born Feb. 28, 1910, in Washington Township, the former Mavis M. Blum, daughter of Fred W. and Mary Speich Blum. She graduated from Monticello High School in 1927 and was married to Max Schuett in Monticello on November 26, 1936.
