Paul C. Schulz, 69, Monroe, died Thursday, June 6, 1996, at the Monroe Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

He was born February 16, 1927, in Orangeville, the son of Lester E. and Mabel I. (Clarno) Schulz.

He graduated from Monticello High School in 1945.

Paul married Darlyne J. Rinehart June 20, 1948, at Stavers United Methodist Church.

They farmed in Cadiz township from 1948 until 1976. He then sold life insurance, worked for Mid-America and the Burnett Bahe Agency.
