

**Werner Stauffacher, 78, Stricken; Rites Held Wednesday
1889 - 1967**

Funeral services for Werner D. Stauffacher, 78 years of age, Monticello, who passed away at 6:30 a.m. Monday at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, as the result of a cerebral hemorrhage, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Robert Buehl, Wilbert J. Dick, Walter Hauri, Jacob Voegeli, Louis Wyss and Walter Zeller.

Mr. Stauffacher had been a patient at the hospital since Thursday morning.

He was born on the Stauffacher homestead farm, New Glarus township, on Jan. 15, 1889, the son of Conrad and Marie Elmer Stauffacher. He attended the Voegeli rural school near his home. He lived on the Stauffacher farm until 1937, when he came to Monticello to make his home. For many years he was a bulk driver for the Marty Oil Co. until his retirement.

Mr. Stauffacher was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

He is survived by two brothers, Conrad, Monticello, now residing at the Monroe Manor nursing home, and Dick, Baraboo; one sister, Mrs. J. U. Freitag, New Glarus; 13 nieces and nephews.

Mr. Stauffacher was preceded in death by three brothers, John, Henry and Fred, and by three sisters, Selina, in infancy, Mrs. Ed. C. Hefty and Mrs. Henry E. Babler.
