Mrs. Elizabeth R. Voegeli, 93, 802 E. Lake Ave., Monticello. died Monday, June 26, 1977, at 9:45 a.m. at St. Clare Hospital after a lingering illness. She had been hospitalized previously, the last time on June 24.

The daughter of Wm. H. and Elizabeth Evans Prisk, she was born on Sept. 7, 1883, in Mt. Pleasant township. She attended rural school and was married on March 4, 1904, at Freeport, to John Voegeli. They farmed in the Monticello and Albany area, later moving to River Falls where they farmed for eight years. They returned to the Monticello area in 1922. Since 1950, Mrs. Voegeli had been housekeeper for the Ed Wallom family, and had since continued to reside here.

She is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Edwin (Eve) R. Koenen, Mt. Calvary, and Mrs. Edward (Fayme) Zierke, Marshfield; one son, Marvin J. Voegeli, Monticello, 12 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, John, in 1954; and eight brothers. Vem Prisk, 1945, Preston Prisk, 1961, William Prisk, 1964, Ora Prisk, 1965, Mark Prisk, 1967, Jackson Prisk, 1975; two sisters, Mrs. Charlotte Ratzel, 1931, and Mrs. Gertrude Stauffacher, 1956; and one daughter, Mrs. Florence Bloedorn (who was a twin of Fayme), Fond du Lac, on Feb. 17, 1977.

She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Monticello.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, June 30, at 2 p.m. in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge. Rev. Charles Workman will officiate and interment will be in Highland Cemetery. Visitation will be held after 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 29.
