

LYDIA WITTENWYLER

Lydia K. Wittenwyler, 99, formerly of Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, died Monday, April 27, 1992, at New Glarus Home where she was a resident since 1983.

She was born April 25, 1893 in Sylvester Township, Green County, the daughter of Abraham and Maria (Baebler) Kubly. She attended Silver Rural School in Mount Pleasant Township. She married Walter H. Wittenwyler Dec. 16, 1913 at Zwingli United Church of Christ parsonage, Monticello. He died Jan. 21, 1982. They farmed in Mount Pleasant Township from 1923 until retirement. They were recognized as the oldest farming couple at the Green County Fair.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello; a former member of the church choir and a former Sunday school teacher and member of the Woman's Relief Corps.

Survivors include three grandsons and three great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband; a son, Harris, April 16, 1988; five brothers, Abraham Jr., Conrad, Henry, John and Daniel; and three sisters, Anna Wittenwyler, Ida Swann and Marie Dooley.

Funeral services were Wednesday, April 29, at Voegeli-Newcomer Funeral Home, Monticello, the Rev. Erwin H. Pegel, officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
