

ROYAL W. "BO" WOELFFER JR.

Royal W. "Bo" Woelffer Jr., age 79, a long-time Monticello resident and businessman, died Tuesday, March 17, at the New Glarus Home. Royal was born January 14, 1919 in Monroe, son of the late Roy W. and Ida W. (Bindschaedler) Woelffer Sr. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1936 and from the University of Wisconsin School of Pharmacy in 1941.

He married Alice Faeser on June 24, 1954 at St. John's United Church of Christ in Monroe. In January of 1949 Royal succeeded his father in operating Woelffer Drug Store of Monticello until retiring in 1995. Mr. Woelffer was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello, the Monticello American Legion Amstutz-Marty Post #256, a former member of the Monticello Community Club, and served on the Monticello School Board for many years.

Survivors include his wife, Alice; three children, Julie (Toyo) Ishida, Wainwright, Alberta; Jan Woelffer, Chicago; Todd Woelffer, Verona; Two grandchildren, Danny and Tariq Ishida, both of Wainwright, Alberta; and a sister, Betty Jane Kaelin, St. Charles, IL. He was preceded in death by his mother in 1976, and his father in 1978.

Funeral services were held Saturday March 21, at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, the Rev. Lawrence Balleine officiated. Interment was in the Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
