

ROBERT J. “JIM” ZENTNER

Robert J. “Jim” Zentner age 73 of rural Monticello, died Friday, October 12, 2012 at the Monroe Manor Nursing Home. Jim was born October 23, 1938 in Albany Township, Green County, Wisconsin, the son of Robert C. and Alice E. (Krause) Zentner. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1956 and entered the U.S. Army on Sept. 5, 1956. He was stationed in Germany and attained the rank of Specialist 4th Class before his honorable discharge on Sept. 4, 1958 at Ft. Sheridan, IL. Jim farmed on the Zentner home farm in Exeter Township all of his life.
