

Wilbur R. Zimmerman

Funeral services were conducted Saturday, July 2, in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, for Wilbur R. (Pete) Zimmerman, 65, Rt. 1, Albany. Mr. Zimmerman died on Wednesday, June 29, 1977, in St. Clare Hospital after a long illness. He had been hospitalized in Madison and Monroe previous to entering St. Clare Hospital on June 24. The Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated at the service and burial was in Highland Cemetery.

He was born in Mt. Pleasant Township on April 5, 1912, attended Attica Rural School and graduated from Albany High School in 1931. He and Wilma L. Schwerin were married on April 6, 1938, at Monticello. After his marriage he farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township on Ct. C just west of Attica.
