NEW GLARUS, WI - Eva Zweifel, age 102, of New Glarus died on Monday, July 20, 2015 at the New Glarus Home. She was born on January 16, 1913 in the Town of Mount Pleasant, the daughter of Herman and Wilma (Schwartzlow) Ringhand. Eva attended the Babler Country School. On November 3, 1934 she married Clarence Zweifel in Freeport, IL. They farmed side by side in the Town of Primrose until 1952 when they moved to New Glarus. Eva retired from Strickler's Meat Market in 1974. In retirement Eva enjoyed the Sugar River Trail, bowling, fishing, traveling, and playing cards. After Clarence passed away in 1990 Eva enjoyed guiding tours at the Swiss Historical Village. In 2003 Eva was recognized as a 60 year volunteer for the American Red Cross. Eva is preceded in death by her husband Clarence in 1990, and her daughter Kathleen in 1997.
