

FRED ZWEIFEL

The funeral for Fred Zweifel, 89, Monticello, was held on Tuesday, Feb. 15, 1977, at 1:30 p.m. in the Newcomer Funeral Home, Monroe, with Rev. Charles G. Workman officiating. Interment was in the Swiss Church Cemetery, New Glarus.

Mr. Zweifel died Sunday, Feb. 13, in St. Clare Hospital, where he had been admitted on Feb. 8.

The son of Fridolin and Barbara Adank Zweifel, he was born on the Zweifel Homestead farm in Washington Township on March 24, 1887. He attended Marty rural school in Washington Township. On Nov. 13, 1913, he and Henrietta Holcomb were married at the home of her uncle and aunt, Mr. and Mrs. Dave Pfeiffer, in Monroe. Rev. P.A. Schuh of St. John's United Church of Christ officiated. Mr. and Mrs. Zweifel observed their 50th wedding anniversary in November, 1963. They farmed on the Zweifel Homestead farm until retiring to the village of Monticello in April, 1967.

He is survived by a son, Clarence, Monticello, and a daughter, Lillian, Monroe.

Preceding him in death were his wife on Feb. 22, 1973, a brother, Joseph, and a sister, Mrs. Ed (Mary) Theiler, Beloit.

He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.
