

Mrs. Nellie E. Zweifel

Mrs. Nellie E. Zweifel, 87, Monticello, died at 6:25 pm. Tuesday, July 29, 1975, in St. Clare Hospital after a lingering illness. She was admitted to the hospital as a medical patient at 10:25 that morning. She had been hospitalized 10 days in June.

The former Nellie E. Krueger, was born in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, Sept. 4, 1887, a daughter of William and Augusta Gehler Krueger. She attended Silver rural school. On Feb. 7, 1909, she was married in Monticello to John P. Zweifel. Mr. Zweifel had been a partner in the Arn & Zweifel Cheese Co. for more than 25 years before his death Sept. 17, 1947.

Mrs. Zweifel was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ and its Ladies' Aid, the John Ross Woman's Relief Corps. and the New Glarus Chapter, Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Mildred Hagen, Waunakee, and Mrs. Thomas E. (Irma) Hamilton, Gaborone, Botswana, Africa, who has been in Monticello during her mother's last illness; two sons, Dwight, Monticello, and Edward W., Madison; a sister, Mrs. Mabel Rhyner, Albany; 13 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.

Three brothers and two sisters preceded her in death: Frank, Henry, William, Mrs. Mary Stanton and Mrs. Emma Holliday.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 pm. Friday, Aug. 1, in Zwingli Church. Rev. Duane McDonough of Washington Reformation Church will officiate in the absence of Rev. Charles Workman, who is on vacation. Burial is to be in Highland Cemetery.

Visitation will be after 7 pm. Thursday in Zwingli Memorial Lounge and after 12 noon Friday in the church sanctuary.
